



2023 Round 1 Chart Selection Criteria

Eligible patient criteria

- 18 or older at diagnosis
- Invasive malignancy or hematologic malignancy

Diagnosis & Visit Window

- Diagnosed: 12/01/2021 – 3/31/2023
- First Office Visit: 12/01/2021 – 5/31/2023
- 2 Office Visits (practitioner): 10/01/2022 – 5/31/2023

End of Life patients only need to meet criteria below

- Patient must have died: 12/01/2021 – 5/31/2023
- Patients must have a known date of death
- Death related to cancer or cancer-related treatment
- 2 office visits (practitioner): Within 12 months preceding death

Notes

- Practitioner is defined as: Licensed independent practitioner, including physicians, advanced practice nurses (nurse practitioner or clinical nurse specialist), and/or physician assistants, as determined by state law
- Date of Diagnosis: Date the specimen was collected for the diagnosis being abstracted
- First Office Visit must occur with a Medical Oncologist or Hematologist Oncologist.
- All patients must be aged 18 or older at the time of diagnosis.
- All patients must have come to the office for cancer care NOT for only a consult or second opinion.
- Abstraction focuses on care for the initial diagnosis and initial course of treatment with the exception of the end-of-life measures
 - Only include charts of patients who had recurrence if the initial diagnosis was made by the practice during the diagnosis window (eligible for end-of-life measures only).
- Charts abstracted for the previous MOQC rounds should NOT be included.

Changes:

- 2 office visits preceding death went from 9 to 12 months.
- No longer exclude charts of patients diagnosed with more than one invasive malignancy during the diagnosis window or if the patient had two distinct breast primaries.
